#### 2020 Operational Plans (draft) - inform

Data reviewed by school staff

- Input into draft Operational plans for 2020
  - o Reading limited change due to ongoing good results
  - Writing continuation of Talk for Writing program to emphasize quality over quantity, significant investment in teacher development time
  - Language Conventions (spelling, grammar and punctuation) remodelled spelling approach K-Y2 (shift from Words Their Way program to Letters and Sounds program to assist transition from PP to Y1)
  - Mathematics inclusion of development of maths facts vocabulary and knowledge in the school community
    - HG previously mathletics uptake was questioned are we still going to invest? PM showed data on mathletics uptake – data

shows clear increase in tasks assigned by staff, use in lower primary and certificates earned – yes, mathletics to be retained, P&C to continue to fund

■ HG – suggested for the school to consider IXL program
