

School Board Information Session

On Wednesday, February 7, class teachers will be conducting meetings with parents and carers to outline class procedures. This meeting is an extremely important first step in the new school year and I sincerely hope everyone can attend.

I will conduct a series of information sessions to coincide with this evening to outline the role of the School Board. Glengarry Primary School has been operating as an Independent Public School (IPS) as of 2015 and this is an opportunity for you to gain an idea of what this means for our school.

The sessions will commence at 5.00pm, 5.30pm and 6.00pm in the School Library and run for approximately 20 minutes. Each session will be essentially the same, i.e. a visual presentation including explanation, with questions to conclude each meeting. School Board members will be invited to attend these meetings to assist with dissemination of information and answer questions.

Nominations for membership to the School Board will be called in the coming weeks for positions vacated due to the expiration of terms.
