

#### **School Board**

The Glengarry Primary School Board is an integral aspect of school operations. As per the Board Constitution, there is a set term for all members (excluding the Principal who is classified as ex-officio) and elections need to be held on a regular basis. At the end of 2023, the following members completed their terms and I thank them for their support:

The School Board is comprised of five parent / carer members of the school community, three staff members and the Principal. All decisions that relate to the overall planning of school operations are discussed at School Board meetings and directions for future development mapped out. Apart from matters relating to staff, the School Board provides advice and support on a wide range of school related issues.

All School Board meetings are open to the public, although at times the general public may be asked to leave the meeting for a short time and only School Board members can vote on any given issue. The dates for meetings are generally printed on each Term Planner so the general community are aware when the group will meet, i.e., the first meeting for 2024 is to be held on Monday, March 25 at 7.00pm in the Staff Room. Items on this agenda include discussion regarding the new Business Plan, the draft of the 2023 Annual Report and a review of 2024 planning.

As a result of the parent / carer vacancy on the Board, an additional member is required from the community for a three-year period. The School Board positions will be decided following nomination and a subsequent election if required.


#### **Student Reports**

You can access your child/ren's student report through Connect. These can be downloaded or printed. Note: Access to this feature may differ from school to school.





### **Every Day Counts**

At Glengarry Primary School we place great importance on good attendance and punctuality. We know that a child's attendance has a direct impact on their learning. Those children who are regularly absent from school and regularly late do not achieve their potential and do fall behind in class. Please support the school in this by ensuring that your child attends school regularly and arrives ready to learn and on time at 8.45am.

The School Education Act 1999 requires children of compulsory school age to attend school (This now applies to Pre-Primary Students). When a child is unable to attend, legislation requires that parents/ caregivers forward written notification providing a reasonable cause for the absence of their child, this can be done by emailing:

When an explanation is not provided to the school within three days of the original day's absence, the class teacher may send a letter requesting an explanation. These letters are printed and sent to families every five weeks.

#### NAPLAN

A reminder to parents of Year 3 and 5 students that NAPLAN assessments take place from Wednesday, 13 March to Monday, 25 March which is Weeks 7 to 9 of Term 1. Assessments are given in reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation and numeracy.

This year, W.A. students will complete the assessments online, except for the Year 3 Writing assessment, which will still be completed on paper. The NAPLAN brochure sent home earlier this term, to the Year 3s and 5s gives more information about NAPLAN. The NAPLAN assessments are one of the methods that schools use to determine the achievement of its students and the effectiveness of the academic program.


- Students Name



(*Returning students:* An email to advise is recommended, so that sessions can be planned and equipped according to participant levels.)

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
#### <u>Glengarry Drive</u> Student Crossing
